

Matamata Country Lodge COVID-19

Update 7 March 2021

Alert Level 1

The New Zealand Government announced the COVID-19 Alert Level drop back to Alert Level 1 (Alert Level 2 for Auckland) from 6:00AM Sunday 7 March 2021.

As a result, Matamata Country Lodge has returned to Level 1 safety rules as follows:

1. Visiting hours will be from 1100am onwards, 7 days a week.
2. Visitors will need to sign in as they enter and sign out as they leave the building (a QR Code is also available).

Therefore visitors will need to enter and exit the buildings by either the:

- Reception entrance (Elizabeth Street); or
- Kowhai (ALC) building main entrance

3. We also ask that visitors:
 - continue to use the hand sanitiser provided
 - stay away if unwell. Note: the flu season has started
4. Our residents will be able to leave the facility eg visits, shopping.
5. Day care and Entertainers will be returning. We will contact the people concerned to recommence the service.
6. Visitors from Alert Level 2 areas (Auckland) will need to wait until their Alert Level drops back to Level 1 before they can enter.
